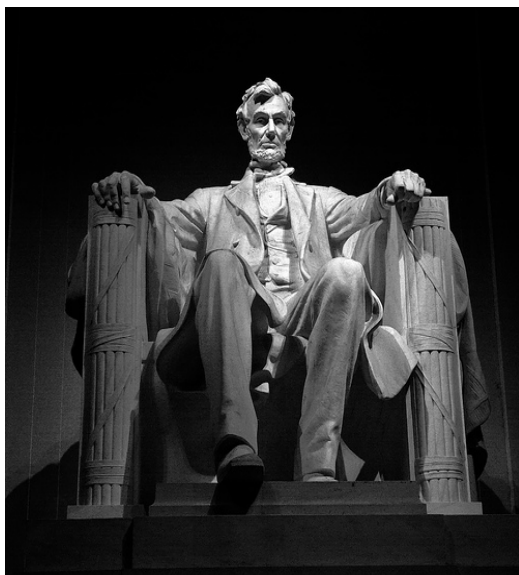


Dennis W. Jahnigen Memorial Award
