Special Point of Interest

As of July 1, online data entry for the IMPRESS and SOLVED studies is expected for trained research coordinators at participating sites.

Every clinical research form and all x-rays must be entered into the online system.

Every two weeks, a study specific report will be generated and sent to participating sites. The report will detail subjects with missing or incomplete forms and missing x-rays. Please look for these reports from Mark via email or fax.

To date 23 of 26 research coordinators are trained and using the system. Training sessions were held in June, July, and August.

ANKLE PLATING STUDY BEGINS

The Antiglides vs. Lateral Plating: A Multicenter Randomized Trial (*Ankle Plating study*) is underway.

This study compares and analyzes lateral vs. posterior plating of patients with Weber B fibula fractures.

Enrollment is off to a great start with 19 patients randomized:

- 9 to antiglide
- 10 to lateral
