Its services allow seniors and persons with disabilities who need assistance with personal care tasks to remain in a home and in the community with a qualified and approved caregiver. Eligibility: To be eligible for services, a recipient must have a physician's order that details their specific daily needs.

- Bathing
- Dressing
- Transferring
- Meal preparation
- Shopping
- Transportation
- Nursing services and oversight
