Know vaccines are safe and effective

After 2 years of COVID-19 vaccines given in pregnancy, research shows:

- No indication of serious side effects
- 99% reduction of hospitalization in vaccinated pregnant women

Know the risks

A COVID-19 infection can be dangerous for you and your baby.

- Higher risk of severe illness and death for parent
- May cause preterm birth or stillbirth
- Baby may need hospitalization
