

# What to know about the COVID-19 vaccine for children

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COVID-19 vaccines are now available for kids aged 6 months to 4 years.  
Moderna = 2 doses  
Pfizer = 3 doses

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Both vaccines were **safe and effective** in clinical trials.

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Very few serious side effects were reported during the clinical trials. Common side effects like mild fever or a sore arm are similar to other vaccines.

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Children who have already had COVID-19 **should still get vaccinated** to protect from reinfection and hospitalization.

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If your child is less than 3 years old, you must go to a certified healthcare provider (like BMC's vaccination teams) to get them vaccinated - you can't go to a CVS!
