If you have **MassHealth Standard** AND you are enrolled in the **BMC HealthNet** plan:

- **John** will bring your car seat soon after you give birth.
- If you haven't had your baby yet, **call John** at (617) 414-6748 to set up an appointment to pick up the car seat. Do so at least **one month** in advance!

Or, if you are **not** enrolled in the BMC HealthNet plan:

- The hospital provides **free** car seats to all those who attend a one-time class on car seat usage.
- The room is hard to find, and you should be there by 10:15. Leave early!
- After attending one of these classes, your free car seat will be mailed to you within **3-5 days**.
