## BOSTON MEDICAL CENTER Research Recovery Plan

As we plan for the resumption of on-campus research, PIs and center directors are required to develop a research recovery plan. Please use the template below to lay out your plans to manage operations while prioritizing physical distancing, staggered work shifts to reduce group size, remote work, and other exposure-reducing measures.

**Rationale for Return to Campus:** Explain why your on-campus work should be prioritized for return when we begin ramping up in-person research.\*

**Physical Distancing:** Describe the plan to ensure distancing of at least 6' between anyone in the lab or participating in research. Please consider lab/bench space, shared equipment, and desk seating.\*



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**Scheduling:** At this phase, the recommendation is for the lab population not to exceed 30% capacity at any time. Describe a schedule or plan to ensure this is not exceeded. Considerations should also be made for commuting options and night/weekend work.\*

**Cleaning:** Who is responsible for cleaning your lab or core facility, and what is the frequency?\*

**Other:** What other plans will you put in place to reduce chance of transmission?

**Ramp-down Plan:** If required to ramp down to only essential research activities, what would those activities be and what steps will be taken to restrict activities as soon as possible?\*

**Human Subjects Research:** Describe the plan to identify study participants who are at increased risk of COVID-19, and provide extra protections, or the plan to phase them in at a later time.
