Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Navigator Programs

PrEP, a pill taken every day, is a highly effective tool to prevent HIV that might be helpful for your loved one. PrEP is used by HIV-negative people at high risk of getting HIV. It is an especially helpful tool for men who have sex with men (MSM), transgender women who have sex with men, people who are in an ongoing sexual relationship with someone who is HIV-positive, and people who inject drugs.
