

## N95 Frequency of Use Summary

**N95s are only to be worn in COVID care areas; please continue to wear surgical or KN masks in common areas.**

Staff who have <u>regular contact</u> with COVID isolation patients or their environment throughout the day	Staff who have <u>episodic contact</u> with COVID isolation patients
<p>Keep your N95 in Tupperware container between uses. Discard at the end of the shift, day or following high risk aerosol generating procedure.</p>	<p><b>Only obtain an N95 when you need one.</b> Keep N95 in Tupperware between uses. Discard at the end of the shift, day or following high risk aerosol generating procedure.</p>
<p>One N95 <u>per shift</u></p>	<p>One N95 <u>per day, if needed.</u></p>
