Click the button above to log into mail.bmc.org and check your BMC mail, set away messages, and view your contacts and calendars.

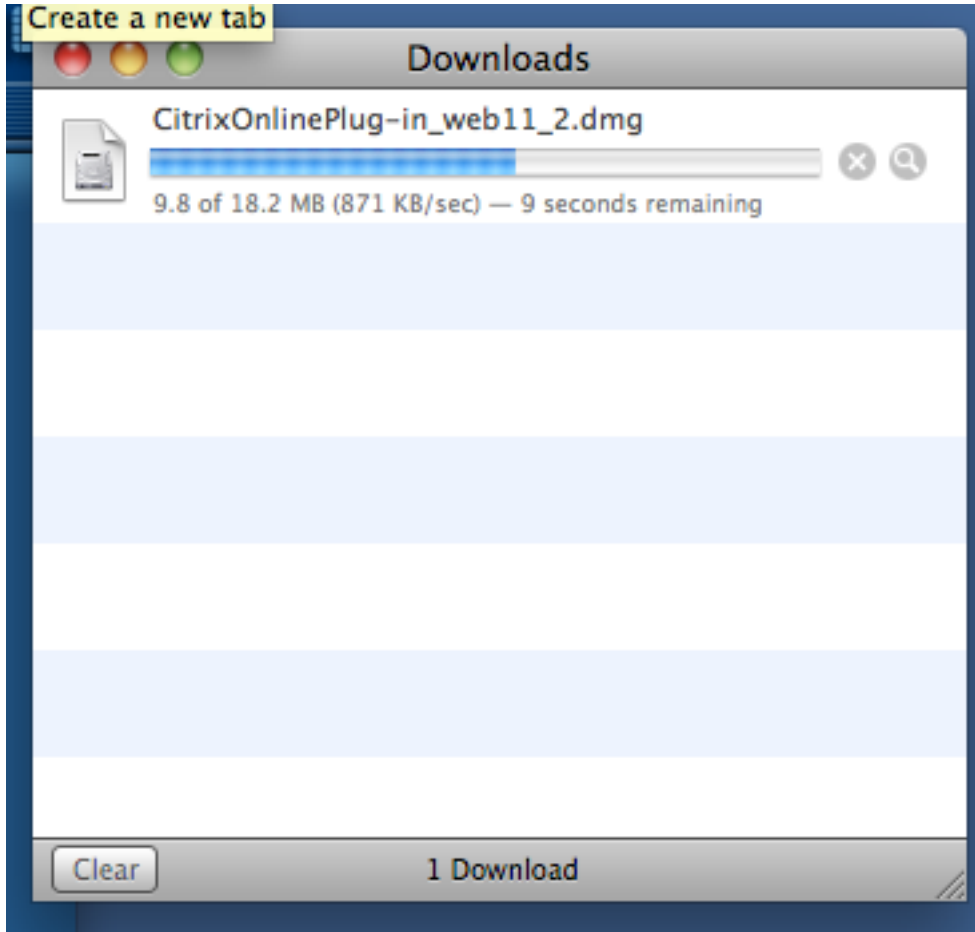
**Clinical Applications >>**  
Click the button above to access SDK, SCM and selected other clinical applications. You will need to have requested an RSA token from the BMC helpdesk to access this area. **The first time you access SCM, you will need to call the BMC Help Desk at (617) 414-4500 to have your pc configured.**

**BMC Employee Benefits >>**  
Click the button above to view or elect your BMC Flex and Retirement benefits online.

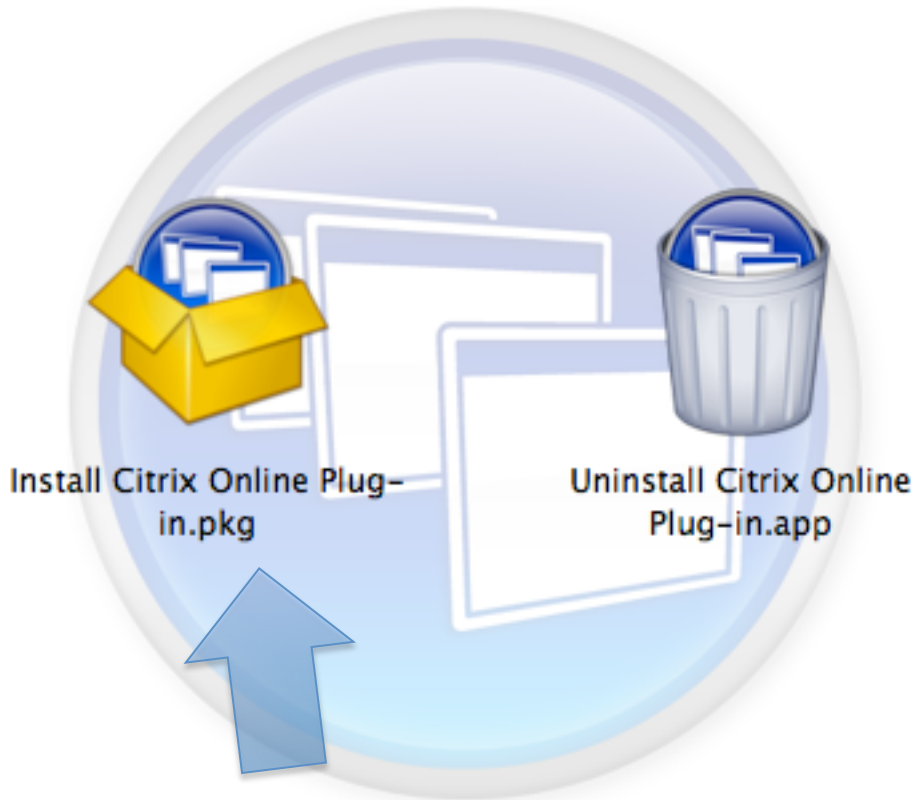
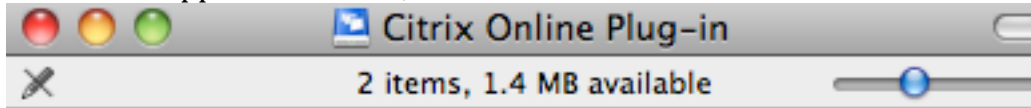
**BMC Employee Portal >>**  
Click the button above to view profile data, compliance and salary information for self and employees that report to you.

**BMC PACS Access >>**  
Click the button above to view BMC GE PACS.

3. The installer will download



4. After the application starts, double click the Install Icon.



5. The application installation begins:

- A. At the Welcome screen, click continue
- B. Observe the License agreement, click continue
- C. Click Agree to agree to the terms of the license
- D. Click install to install on the system device, usually the Macintosh HD
- E. Enter your local password
- F. Click "Close" to end the installation.

6. That's it! Return to [www.mybmc.org](http://www.mybmc.org) and choose Clinical Applications on the right. You're all set to access the applications.
